- On show day you may call (540) 230-5698 for information on the progress of classes.
- Virginia Department of Agriculture requires each horse have a current, within 12 months, Negative Coggins test. Please bring it to the Show Office to make your entries. We are required to provide a copy to VDACS.
- Show is sanctioned by the Blue Ridge Horse Force, all classes indicated with an asterisk (*). A copy of BRHF rules is on hand in the show office. The show is open to all, membership in the sanctioning organization is not required. You can learn more about Blue Ridge Horse Force at: www.brhf.com
- BRHF Exhibitors in the Coached Division, classes 3, 8, 24 & 30, may also (and only) cross enter in class 22 Leadline and class 24 In Hand Trail. Participants in the Coached Division will have their own divisional Championship, limited to these classes.
- No classes will be combined; Show Management reserves the right to split classes, if warranted.
- Points for divisional Championships (Adult, Youth, Schooling and Coached) will be awarded: 1st place, 7 points; 2nd 5 points; 3rd 4 points; 4th 3 points; 5th 2 points; and, 6th 1 point.
- The following classes count, by division: Adult 3 through 5, 11 through 13, 20 through 23, 30 and 31, 33 through 36, 41 through 44, 47 through 49; Youth 8 through 13,20 through 23, 30 and 31,33 through 36, 41 through 44, 50 through 52; Schooling 1 and 2, 6 and 7, 14 through 17, 25 through 28, 37 through 40, 45 and 46, 53 and 54; Coached 18, 19, 22, 24, 29, 32.
- Persons electing to wear ASTM certified safety helmets will not be penalized in any class.
- This is a private facility. Please leave your dogs at home. NO SMOKING on the premises. Thanks for keeping it clean!
- Please let us know if you are bringing is a 4 horse or larger trailer... so that we can prepare our parking plan! We have limited parking for large trailers on the upper parking deck with overflow in the field
- The show management will remove from the premises any one posing a danger to themselves or others.
- Judges decisions are final; unsound horses will be excused.

- Directions to the Farm:
 - o From Interstate 81: Exit 118B towards Blacksburg, go 12.5 miles and turn right on Coal Bank Hollow Road (it's a sharp right turn, come slow with your trailer), go 1.5 miles turn left on Mount Tabor Road, go .8 miles, turn left on Dori Del Hills. This is our farm road, gravel with four board natural rail fence on both sides. Come up the drive, .2 miles, to the Equine Complex.
 - o **If traveling by GPS**: the address is 4190 Dori Del Hills, Blacksburg, VA Coming from I-81, **use exit 118B**, and approximately 3 miles from the farm **DO NOT take Bishop Road**, it is too narrow for trailers, go past it to Coal Bank Hollow.
 - o From Pearisburg, on US Route 460 E.: pass through Pembroke, and Newport (intersecting road is Route 42) and come another 4.6 miles on 460 E, (almost at the base of Brush Mountain, it's steep, slow down early, you will turn before the road sweeps to the right) turn left on Coal Bank Hollow Road, go 1.5 miles turn left on Mount Tabor Road, go .8 miles, turn left on Dori Del Hills. This is our farm road, gravel with four board natural rail fence on both sides. Come up the drive, .2 miles, to the Equine Complex.
 - Coming from US Route 460 there is signage that says "GPS Routing not recommended on Route 624" do not be concerned, the area of difficulty is past the Ranch.
